Historic Environment Record aka a Sites and Monuments Record

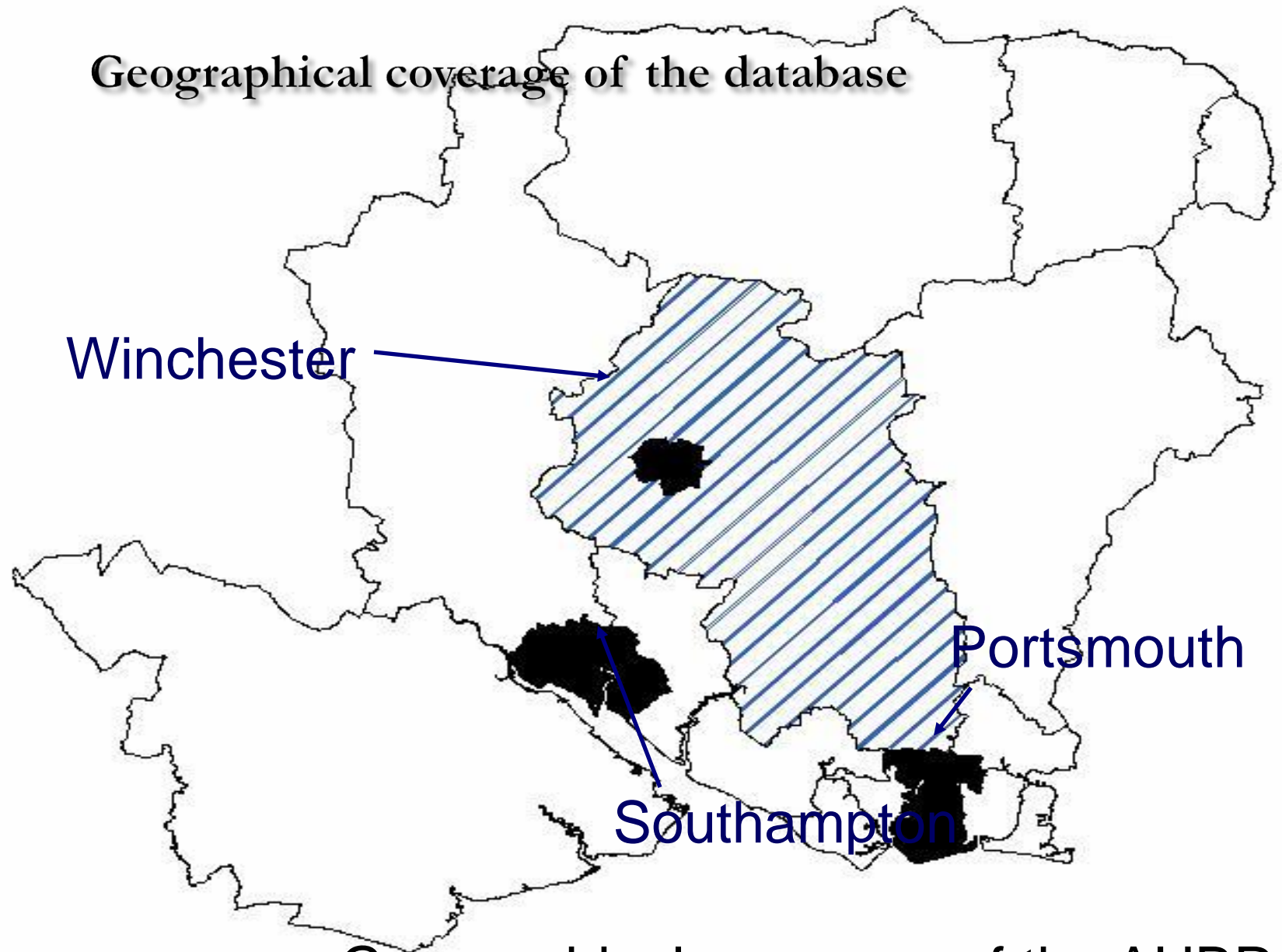
- SMRs first developed in the 1960s based on OS Record Cards
- Enhanced by trawl of published information and statutory notifications such as for Scheduled Ancient Monuments
- Following PPG16 in 1990s SMRs expanded through the increasing volume of reports from archaeological contract work.
- By the late 1990s....

“an index to known archaeological sites, finds, historic buildings, landscapes, and industrial monuments in Hampshire”

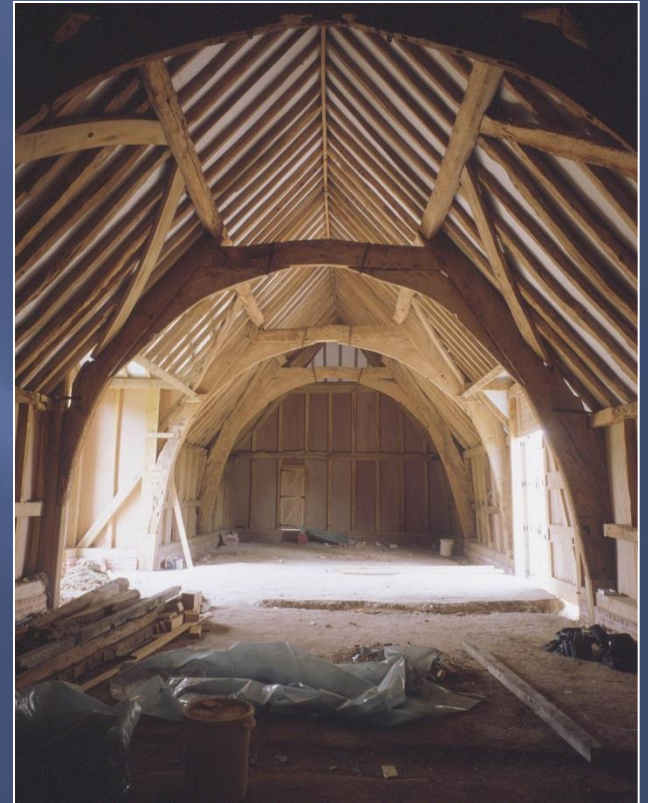

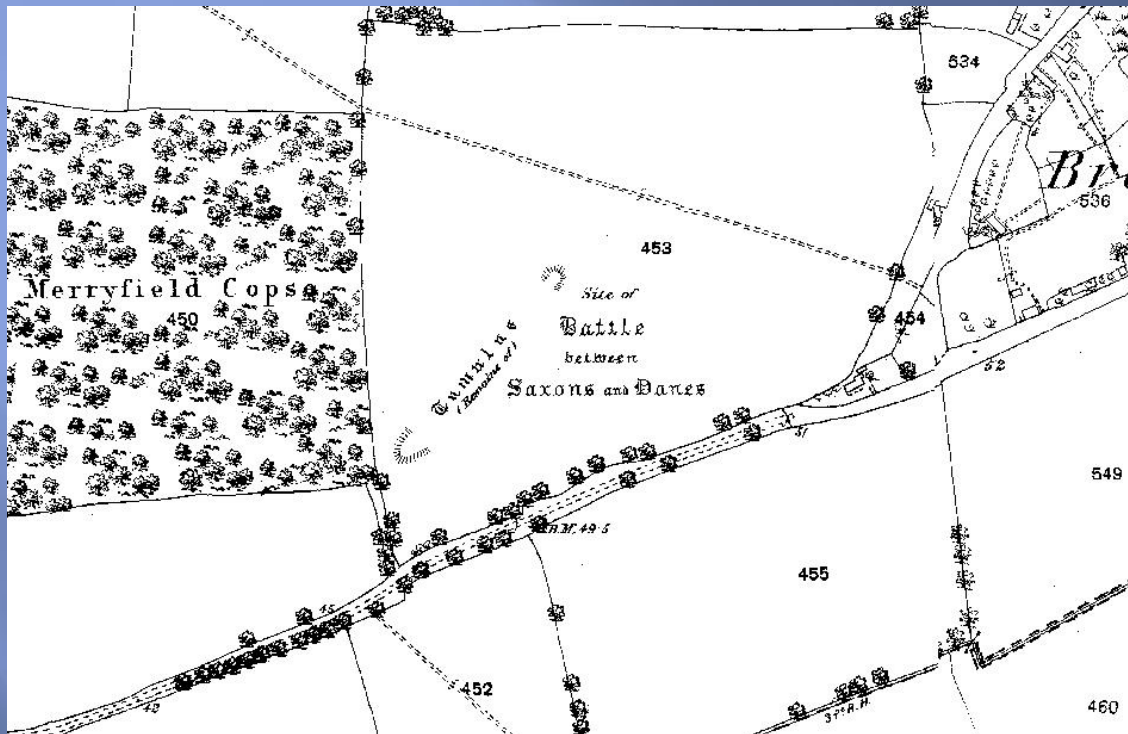

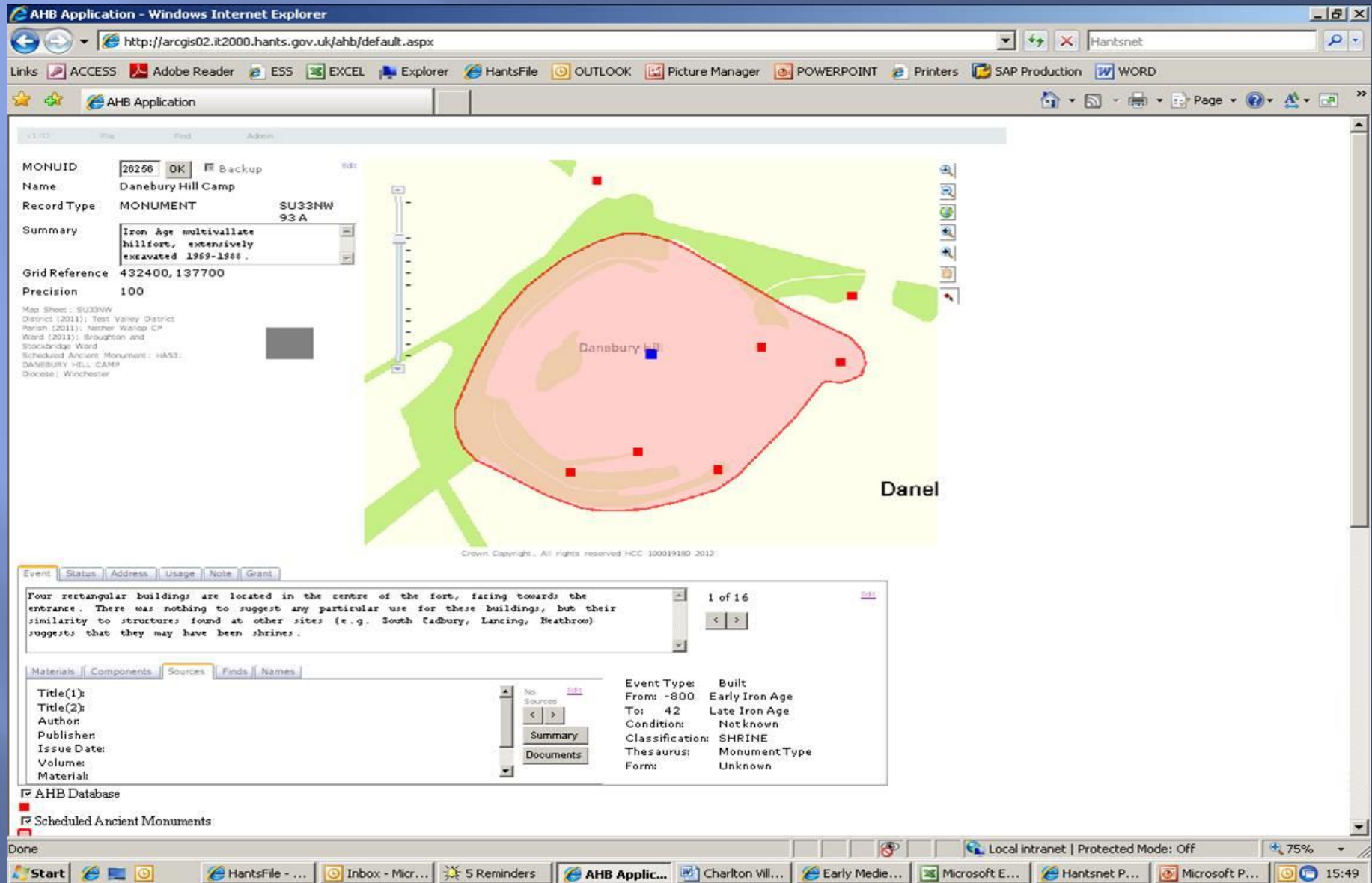

Select	26060	MONUMENT	Bowl barrow, E side of Danebury Hill Camp	Early Bronze Age	Nether Wallop	1 A bowl barrow, 30m in diameter and c1.8m high. The mound has an Ordnance Survey trig pillar on top.
Select	26062	MONUMENT		Early Bronze Age	Nether Wallop	1 A large bowl barrow about 15m in diameter and 1.2m high. (1956, confirmed 1965 and 1968)
Select	26063	MONUMENT		Early Bronze Age	Nether Wallop	1 A barrow is marked on an O G S Crawford record map. (1954). No barrow is visible at this location although a lynchet crossing the hedge some 40m to the south of this location may have been mistaken for one.
Select	26111	MONUMENT		Early Bronze Age	Longstock	1) Another possible round barrow was located on the parish boundary by L V Grinsell (1954). No trace of a barrow is visible at this location (1968).
Select	26114	MONUMENT		Early Bronze Age	Longstock	1) A small bowl barrow 12m in diameter and 0.2m high. The mound appears to overlay a possible ranch boundary which runs east-west (1965)

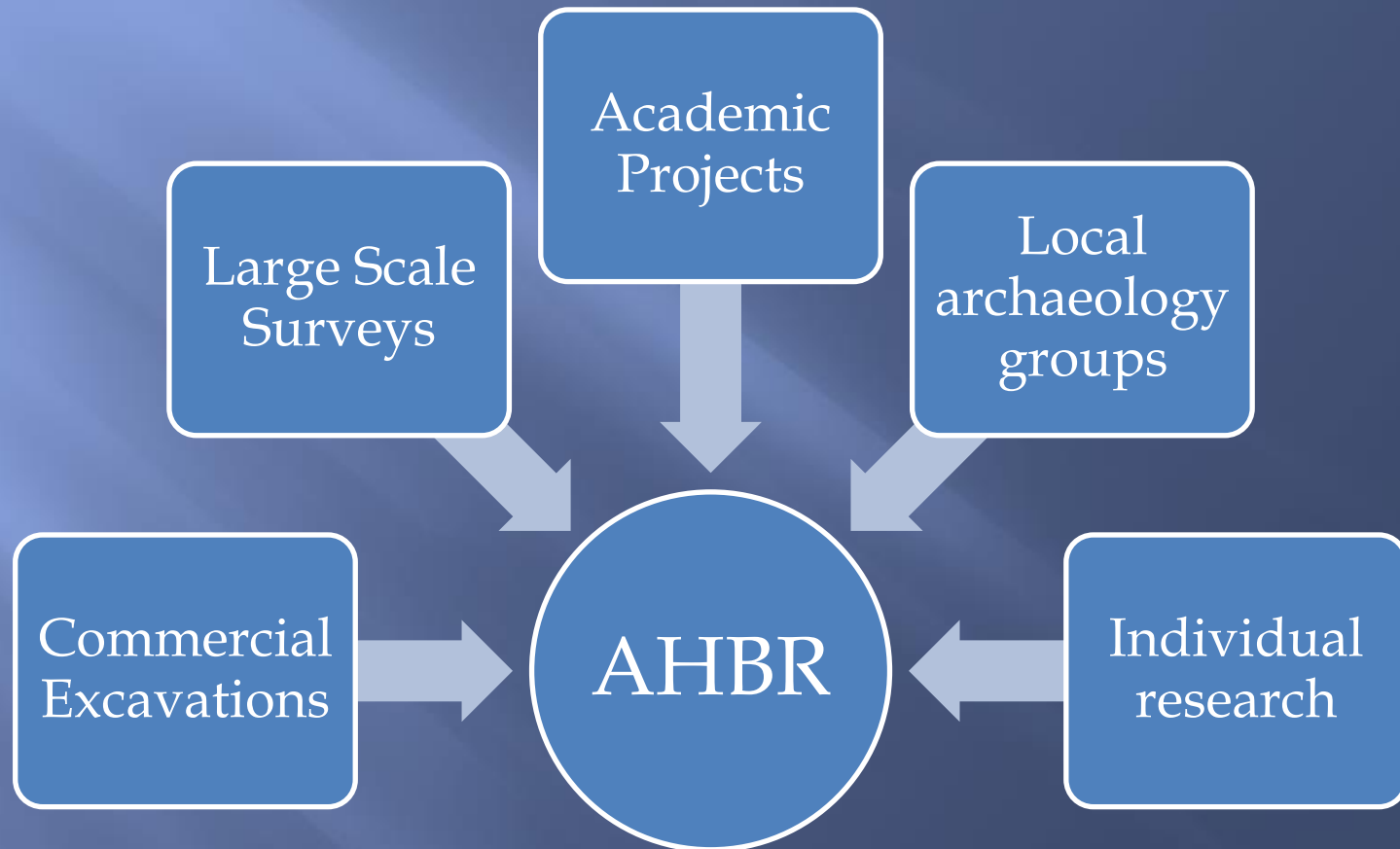

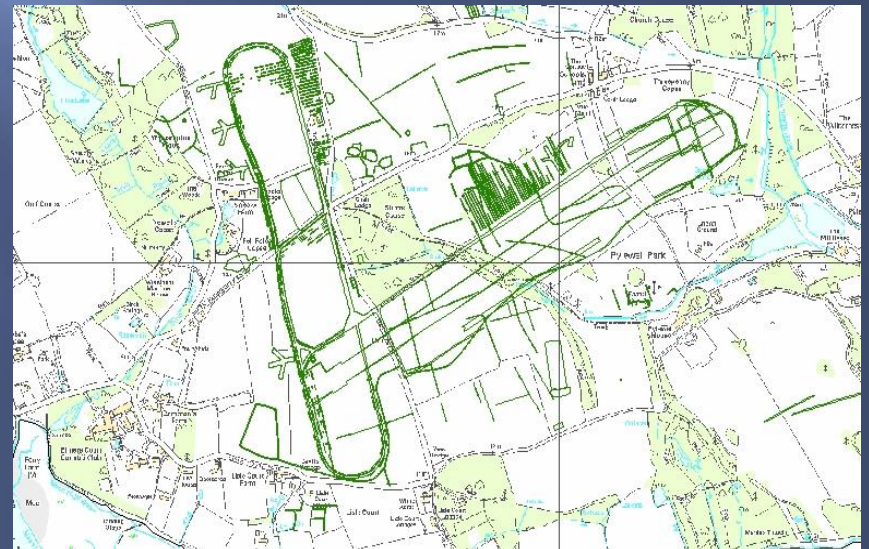

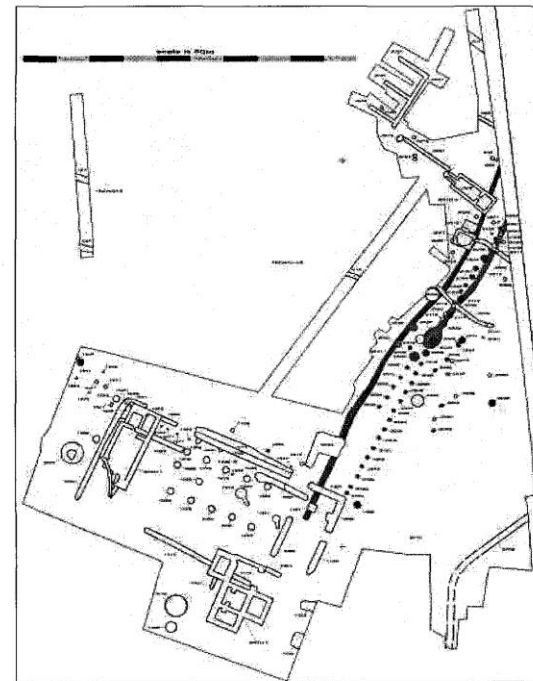
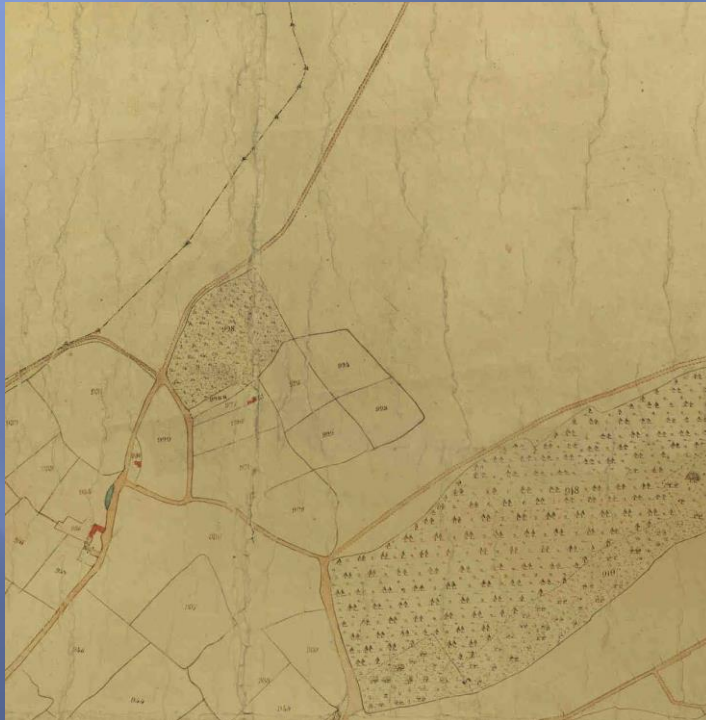


Figure 3 Location of Iron Age post-holes (indicated in red) in Trench 5/6.
