Historic Environment Record aka a Sites and Monuments Record

SMRs first developed in the 1960s based on OS Record Cards

• Enhanced by trawl of published information and statutory notifications such as for Scheduled Ancient Monuments


• Following PPG16 in 1990s SMRs expanded through the increasing volume of reports from archaeological contract work.

"an index to known archaeological sites, finds, historic buildings, landscapes, and industrial monuments in Hampshire"








Figure 3 Location of Iron Age post-holes (indicated in red) in Trench 5/6.
